

STEVEN FRANK



Steven Frank was born on the 27th July 1935 in Amsterdam Holland. He is the middle child of three sons. His father, born in Holland was a distinguished lawyer who was a member of the Dutch resistance. He was betrayed and subsequently imprisoned by the Germans and finally murdered in Auschwitz in January 1943. His mother was born in England and came to Holland to study.

After an idyllic childhood prior to the invasion of Holland, he was deported to Barneveld in March 1943, then to Westerbork in September 1943 and finally to Theresienstadt in the Czech Republic in September 1944 where he survived along with his two brothers and mother. They were liberated by the Russian Army on the 9th May 1945.

The family arrived in England in June 1945 by a devious route through war torn Europe to be reunited with his mother's family, and he has remained there ever since.

Steven Frank is married and has three children and seven grandchildren.
